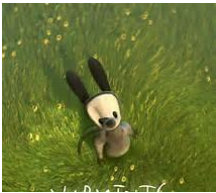


## Year Six Newsletter

**English** We will be continuing work on the 'Varmints' book and writing a variety of texts including a story beginning, a newspaper report and some writing of the children's choice.

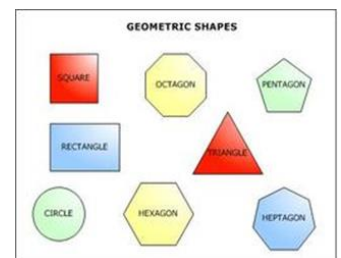

**Carnival Week** We will be having a whole school 'Carnival of Culture' before the summer holidays.

The children will get the opportunity to learn about a range of different countries and cultures.
