Dear Parent/Guardian,

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR HELP WITH CLUBS, TRIPS AND MUSIC?

Are you aware that you could save money?

Your child may qualify to release Pupil Premium Funding to school. This is additional money provided to schools from the Government to help your child access as much support for their learning as possible.

In our school, we use this money in lots of different ways and you can read about this on our website. In particular, you may be aware that we support parents with the costs of some activities so that it is easier for your child to benefit from them. This is because we know that activities like these help children develop strong learning attitudes, skills and strategies, healthy lifestyles and children really enjoy these positive experiences.

These activities are:

- **After-School Clubs** - up to 2 different clubs per half-term
(this means you could save up to £70 per term)
- **Lessons to learn to play a musical instrument**
(there are many different ones to choose and you could save up to £55 a term with this cost)
- **Free School Meals** for children in Years 3 to 6 – a saving of £11:00 every week!
(currently ALL CHILDREN in Years R, 1 and 2 already receive Free School Meals from the Government).

If your annual family income is less than £16,190 per annum you can apply for this for your child. It is very simple and is an extremely confidential process.
