Agreed pedagogy for the teaching of PSHE/RSE at St Mary and St Peter Catholic Primary School

In our school, we agree that the following core strands are crucial to the successful delivery of the PSHE/RSHE curriculum:

- Links to the assembly theme for that week – evidence of the theme running throughout the week, not just the lesson.
- An open and respectful environment in which everyone feels safe to contribute.
- References made to previous learning through the use of big books.
- Lessons will be tailored to current events both within and outside of school.
- Discussion and drama will be regularly used to capture pupil voice.
- Children will be taught how the knowledge and skills they are learning can be applied to other areas of learning (cross-curricular) and to the wider world.
- Children are given a safe space to question, share views and develop their thinking.
- Children know how to keep themselves and others safe.
- Children know the importance of being respectful to others and celebrate differences.
