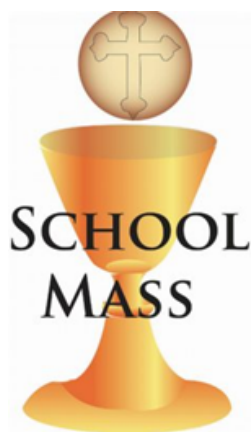

## School Values

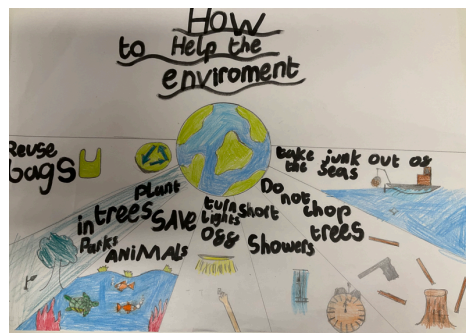
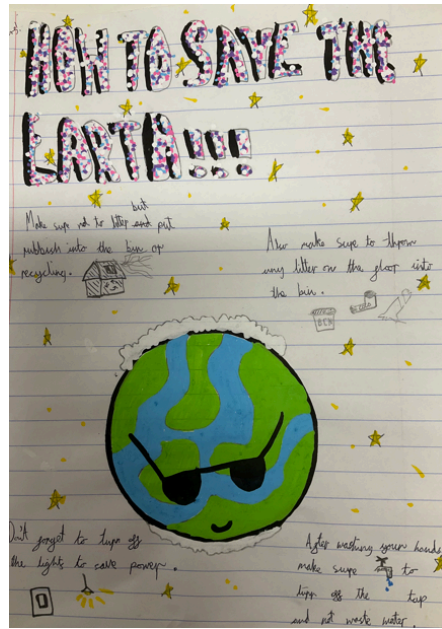
**Believe, Love,
