Learning

At the start of term the children's learning will be based around the theme of Summer time. The children will be going on a walk around the school grounds looking at seasonal changes and compare summer time to the other seasons. The children will also get the opportunity visit the school pond and participate in pond dipping looking at pond life at this time of year.

Following this the children's learning will be focused around the topic of The Seaside. We will be focusing on the text "1, 2, 3 Counting in the sea" by Sue Hendra and we will be discussing the rhyming words in the text. The children will be learning to retell the story and learn to use descriptive language to describe a variety of sea creatures. In maths the children will be learning to count out different sea creatures linked to the story as well as learning to understand 'one more' and 'one less' than.

In RE we will be discussing how we can follow in Jesus' footsteps and be good citizens showing kindness, respect, sharing fairly and understanding that everyone is special.

Home Learning:
