



Curriculum overview in Y2 for Summer Term 2

Religious Education

This half term we are focusing on our local and global Christian community and how we can help to improve our local community. We will be exploring the parable of the good Samaritan and reflecting on the question 'who is my neighbor?' We will also be looking at how different communities worship and how they may be similar or different to Christianity.

PSHE

In PSHE this half term, we are focusing on our communities and being good neighbors. We will be learning about respecting each other and how our behaviors can impact others.

PE

This half term the children will be learning about athletics in the Tuesday lessons with Mrs Phair. On Wednesdays our focus will be striking and fielding. We will be learning how to work as a team and intercept a ball. We will also be developing our throwing, passing and striking skills as well as learning how to follow rules in a game.

English

This half term we are writing narratives based on the short film Zahra. We will be focusing on character descriptions and using powerful vocabulary and adverbs to add detail to our story. We will also be extending our sentences using 'when, if, that, and who'. Our grammar focus will be on using a range of punctuation including!?. and, to add variety to our writing as well as using inverted commas for speech.



Maths

Our maths focuses for this half term are time and measurement. We will be exploring how to use the hands of a clock to tell the time to every 15 minutes as well as recognizing how to read digital clocks and find differences in time. We will also be exploring different ways to measure objects, including weight, length and capacity.

'Set Sail for Success'

History

In History this half term we will be answering the question 'why is Lord Nelson considered a national hero?' We will be exploring his life and the events that led up to the battle of Trafalgar. We will also be looking at how Nelson is linked to Norfolk and what evidence we have of him in our local area.

Science

In science we will be investigating Animals and their habitats. We will be looking at different habitats and how they provide for the animals and plants that live there. We will also be creating simple food chains and exploring what lives in the micro habitats around our school.

Art

In our art lessons we will be using clay to create 3D sculptures based on the works of Andy Goldsworthy and Richard Long. We will be using natural objects to create lines and patterns and then sculpting these out of clay.

Computing

Our focus for Computing this half term is coding. We will continue to learn how computers work with a series of instructions and practice creating our own code.
