Things to Remember:

Library books – the children are invited to take school library books home for you to share together. Sharing books is a great way to develop children's speaking and listening skills. The nursery library books are located in the nursery cloakroom area just inside the door and you are invited to sign in and out library books as you wish.

Polite reminder – please ensure that all of the children's clothing/bags/wellies/water bottles have their name written clearly on them so that we can ensure items are returned to their correct owner.

Starting School

The children have settled into nursery beautifully and have been busy exploring the nursery environment. They have been getting used to the nursery routine, learning to recognise their own names to self-register, coming together on the carpet to share in our daily prayers and story times, learning how to take care of equipment and to tidy toys away when they have finished playing with them. We have been working on developing the children's independence and please continue to support this at home by encouraging your child to put on their own shoes and coats, including teaching them to fasten their zips and buttons.

<u>Learning</u>

During the next few weeks the children's learning will be based around the topic of 'Marvellous Me'. Adults will be spending time playing alongside the children to really get to know them better, finding about their likes and dislikes. The children will create self-portraits and learn that 'God made me' and how he made us all unique and special. In RE the children will be finding out about all the things that God made and will go on a walk around the school grounds to look closely at the things that God created for us to enjoy.
